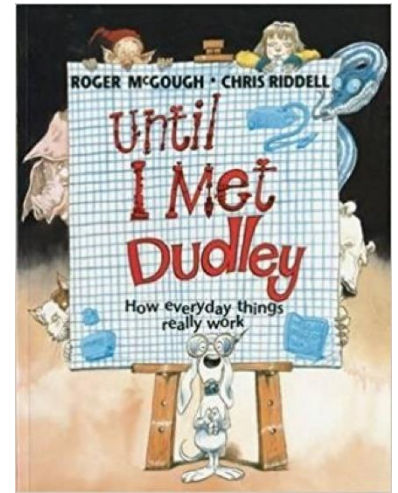


BLAST FROM THE PAST

Remember to write it in two parts: what actually happens and Dudley's version of events!

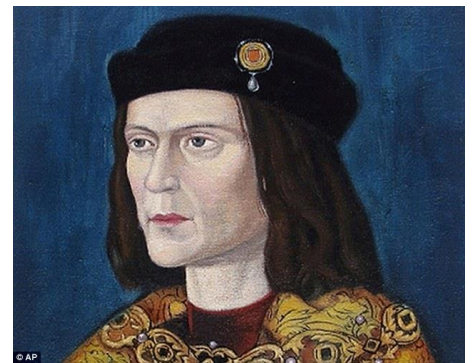


Orrrf with one's head!!
