All our cohorts of children vary from year to year and they are never a direct comparison. To put it simply; some year groups might have more boys to girls, some year groups are avid readers and others find reading more challenging, some children get more support at home than others and some year groups can be sportier or more creative than others which is why we offer such a varied curriculum with a variety of opportunities.

Every year, schools have to report to the Department of Education and the Local Authority on their performance of statutory tests or milestones within their education journey. This data is used to inform the School Improvement Plan for the following year.

## **End of Key Stage 2 (Year 6)**

For both 2023 and 2024, I am putting into the table both published and unpublished data for Nursling. As I said in the beginning, all cohorts are different. Unfortunately, the published data includes the whole cohort, regardless as to whether they sat the test or not.

In 2023, only 24 out of 28 children actually sat the tests.

Three children did not sit the tests because they had arrived from Ukraine within 12 months of the SATS tests. It would not have been fair for them to sit the SATS papers. The fourth child was disapplied.

In 2024, 1 child was disapplied.
