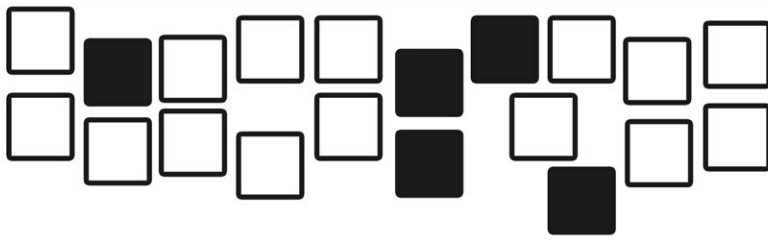
12. A farm has sheep, pigs and cows at a ratio of 8:3:2. There are 10 cows, how many pigs and sheep are there?
