Have a go at making an Easter wreath

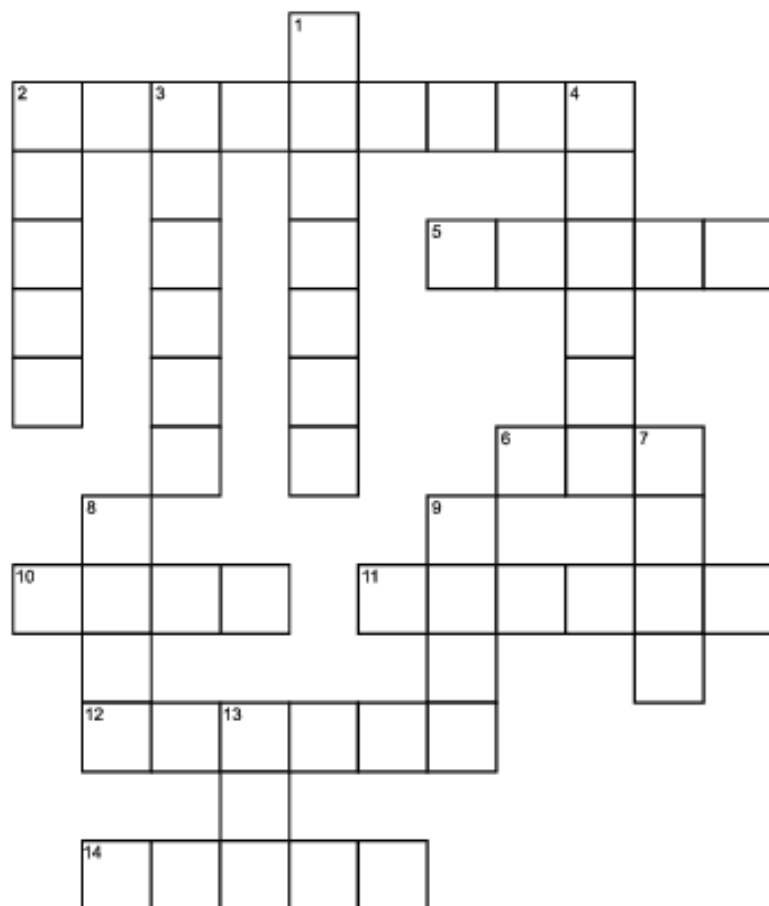

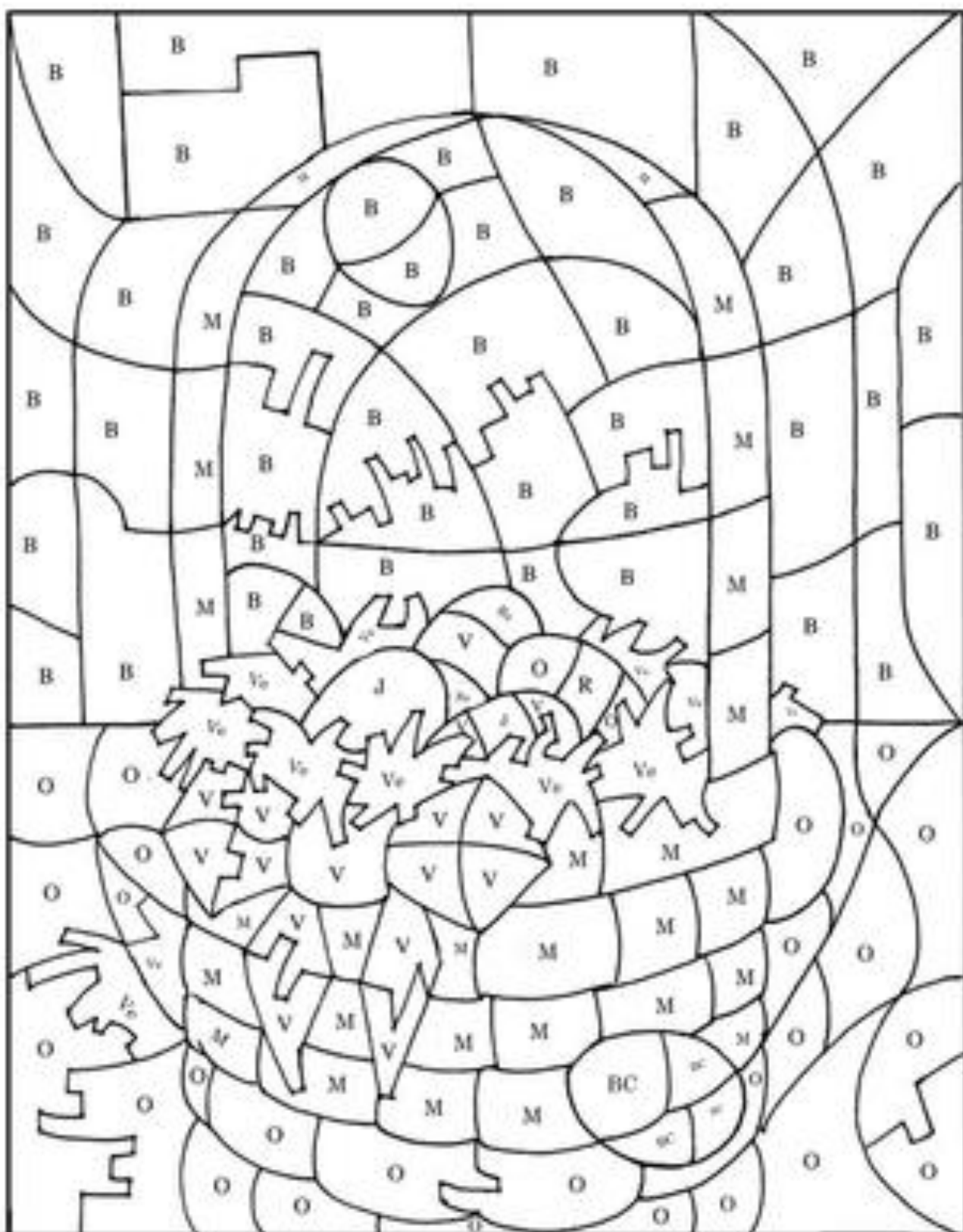
