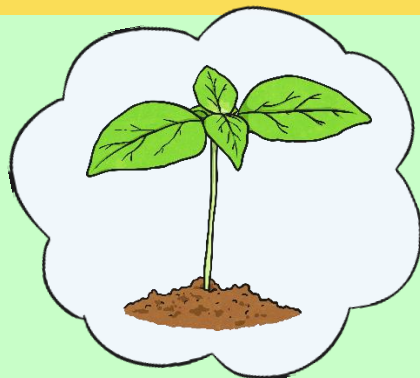

# Let's Get Planting



## How to Plant a Bean Seed

Do you know how Jack grew his magic beans? Just follow these simple instructions, and you may soon be climbing to the Giant's house up your own beanstalk!

**Equipment:** bean seeds; small pot; soil; spoon; ice pole stick or sticky label; pen; watering bottle

**Method:**

Write your name on the sticky label or ice

Stick it to the edge.

Dig the soil approximately 3cm deep.

- With your fingers, brush the soil back over the seed.
- Very gently, press down on the surface of the soil so you do not squash the seed.
  - Push the ice pole stick down the inside of the pot or stick the label on the outside.
  - Sprinkle enough water over the soil to make it damp but do not overwater the seed.
  - Put your pot in a warm place.
  - Wash your hands thoroughly.

Now all you're waiting for is to see your beanstalk start to grow!



# Let's Get Planting



## How to Plant a Bean Seed

Do you know how Jack grew his magic beans? Just follow these simple instructions, and you may soon be climbing your very own beanstalk!

**Equipment:** bean seed, pot, soil, ice pole stick or sticky label; pen; watering bottle

### Method:

- First, gather all your equipment together and lay it out on a flat surface. Use the sticky label or ice pole stick.
- Next, spoon soil into your pot until it is about three-quarters full. Reach just below the edge of the soil with your finger.
- When you have done this, use the pen to create a hole in the soil approximately 3cm deep.
- Drop the bean seed into the hole.
- With your finger, gently press the soil down over the seed.
- Very gently, press the soil down over the seed so you do not squash the seed.
- Push the ice pole stick or sticky label into the soil so it is straight up and down.
- Sprinkle enough water over the soil to make it damp but do not overwater the seed.
- Put your pot in a warm place.
- Wash your hands thoroughly.

Now all you're waiting for is to see your beanstalk start to grow!

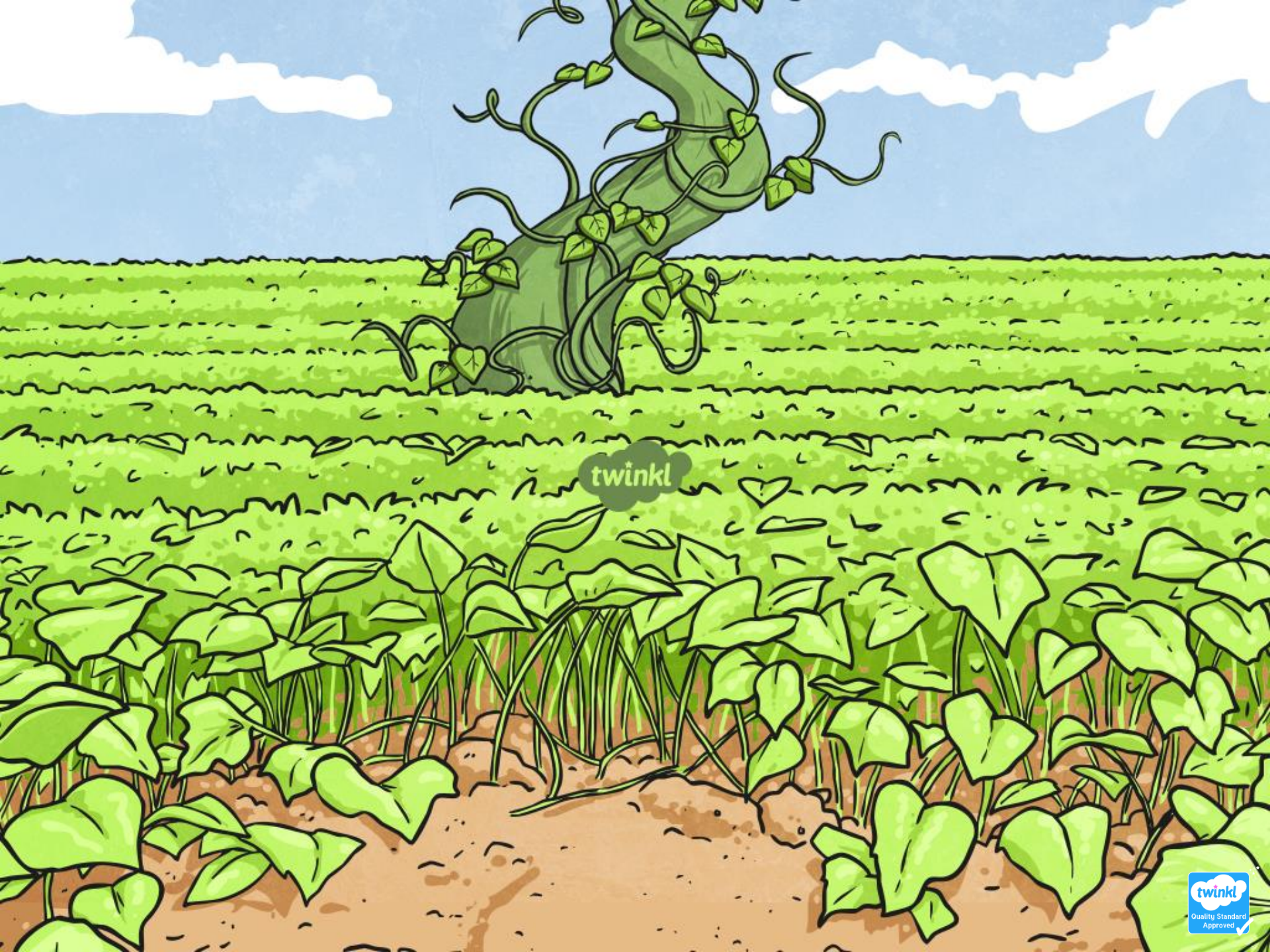
