## English Lesson 2

## English Lesson 3

Write the next chapter in the book using your boxed up plan from the previous lesson. Try to remember to include the use of paragraphs and when to move onto a new paragraph (change in time, place, person, topic or a new person is speaking).

## English Lesson 4

Read Chapters Seven and Eight of the book. Complete the zone of relevance for the words you have read. Write the words you think are most important to the story in the middle circle, and the words that are less important in the outer circle. Once you have organised the words, pick a few and explain why you think they are important to the story.

## English Lesson 5

Time for another speed write. You have a 5-minute planning period and 20 minutes of writing and in this time they write as much as they can. Their writing can take any form and be written for anybody to read, but has to be related to the following picture:
