Noun phrases (slide 10 of PowerPoint)

Noun phrases are used to add more information to the noun in the sentence. When improving our writing, it is important to add more information to the noun to excite the readers more. We have previously looked at this by combining adjectives and nouns. To improve our sentences further we can use noun phrases and expanded noun phrases.

Lesson 2

Adverbial phrases (slide 12 of PowerPoint)

We all know that adverbs are used to add more information to the verbs and usually are the words that end in -ly. However we can also do this in a different way, we can add an adverbial phrase. The phrase has the same effect as using an adverb on its own but adds more information.

The story can be about you (1st person) or about somebody else (3rd person). Make the story as detailed as you can, making sure that your nouns have been described and how the action is taking place.
