This week we are going to be looking at Beowulf. This is an Epic poem and legend from the Anglo Saxon era. It is a complicated poem so it may take a while to break the poem down and understand it.

### Lesson 1

Read the first page of the poem. Write down or highlight all the challenging words that are in the poem. Using a dictionary on the computer or electronic device, try and find the meaning of the words, remember that if the word is in the middle of a sentence and has a capital letter it is likely to be a name.

## Lesson 2

Read the rest of the poem and tell your parent, guardian or sibling what the poem is about.

### Lesson 3

Create a story board on the story board provided based on the Legend of Beowulf. If you want to add some information to your story board from the poem that might be helpful.

### Lesson 4

Write the story of Beowulf in your own words. Make sure you include all the points that you have written in your story board.

# Lesson 5

Write your own legendary story. You can create your own character or use one that you have already heard about or seen.
