1	Solve the word problems linked to our topic area of measure. Either solve them by drawing your own number line or dienes, whichever method you normally use in class.	Word problems sheets
2	Sort the different items into the table based on which unit of measure is the most sensible to use to measure them.	Choosing the units of measure worksheet
3	Read the scales on the measuring jugs and write their capacity.	Worksheets included.
4	Practise 2x and 5x table wheels.	Times tables practise sheets
5	Choose 5 different items from your home that water can be put into. Estimate how much water they will hold and order them using the sheet provided. Then, if you have a measuring jug weight and see how much water they actually hold. I have written 5 items you could use as a suggestion but please change these if necessary.	Capacity worksheet
