Dear Parents and Carers,

Communication

I will not be able to take phone calls at the end of the day for personal feedback.

When we are more settled, we will start using Tapestry to communicate some of the great learning that takes place in school and we will look forward to you uploading some progress and achievements made at home too.

First Aid

We do not inform you of everything that occurs in school but please be reassured that if a serious injury occurs (for example a bumped head/sickness) you will receive a text or phone call from the school office. If it is a minor injury (for example a grazed knee) this will be treated and written in our first aid file but you won't receive any notification.

Safeguarding

Keeping all children safe at school is of paramount importance. Please ensure you support all our school rules and expectations, in particular, not playing on the castle before or after school. The castle must only be used when supervised by a school staff member.
